# **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Q: When is the AHS Swim and Dive season?

A: Swim and Dive is technically a "winter" sport, though it begins in the fall. The exact schedule is determined by GHSA. For the 2022-2023 school year, team practices begin October 5, and the season ends with State in February.

#### Q: Are there tryouts?

A: Though there are no formal tryouts, the coach reserves the right to post a roster of swimmers should it be necessary. Students with no experience who cannot perform the basic skills will not be scheduled for meets.

#### Q: How often and where does the team practice?

A: The team practices four times a week, one of those being at Allatoona High School. If you're a year-round swimmer, we ask that you attend at least one practice a week and that you provide the coaches with your schedule prior to our first practice. MOST PRACTICES ARE AT THE WEST COBB AQUATIC CENTER. AND TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED.

<u>Tuesday:</u> 6:00-7:00 pm

Wednesday: AT AHS 3:45 pm -5:00 pm

<u>Thursday:</u> 6:00-7:00 pm

Dive practices are Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from either 7-8 OR 8-9 at the Cobb Aquatic Center. More information to come.

#### Q: How does an Athlete letter?

A: In order to letter, an athlete must complete one of the following:

- a. Place at County
- b. Qualify for State
- c. Notable improvement quantified by dropping time throughout the season
- d. Demonstrate excellent sportsmanship
- e. Be deemed earning a varsity letter by the coaching staff (including by not limited to coachability, serious participation in practice, investment, etc.)

#### Q: What equipment is required for athletes?

A: All athletes are expected to have a swimsuit, goggles, a swim cap, and any/all additional items recommended by the booster club.

#### Q: What type of spirit wear do athletes get?

A: Students MUST purchase a swimsuit, goggles, and cap. They will be given a team t-shirt and sweatshirt. Additional items will be available for purchase from our team store and the BSN online store. Links are available in our Stack Team app; I do recommend that students purchase the sweatshirt, long-sleeve, and possibly sweatpants.

# Allatoona High School Athletics Policies

#### 1. GENERAL OBJECTIVES

Athletes are student-athletes and must strive to achieve the highest standards both academically and physically. Competing for Allatoona High School is a privilege, not a right.

#### 2. BEHAVIOR AND DISCIPLINE

As a member of the Allatoona Swim and Dive Program, you are expected to maintain the behavior above reproach. Consequences for violating any regulation in this constitution will be at the discretion of the coach and will be handled according to the rules of Allatoona High School, the Georgia High School Association, and Cobb County policy. Please keep in mind the following:

- Any behavior that is deemed by the coach as reflecting poorly on the intended image of the program, no matter where the incident takes place, is subject to dismissal from the program at the coach's discretion. This includes, but is not limited to, pictures and/or videos on social media and inappropriate behavior in public (even if not in program apparel).
- Athletes who receive ISS will not be allowed to participate in any activities during the assigned ISS period.
- Athletes who receive OSS will not be allowed to participate in any activities during the assigned OSS period and will be subject to immediate dismissal at the coach's discretion.

#### 3. TRANSPORTATION

Athletes will be expected to travel to meets with their parents or individually if they have a driver's license. Athletes will be allowed to go home with parents/other modes of transportation with the correct documentation filled out. No athletes will be released from the meet without documentation from the parent/guardian.

#### 4. ELIGIBILITY

Athletes must...

 Pass three out of four classes each semester and be on track academically towards graduation at the end of the year.

#### **5. VARSITY LETTERS**

To be eligible for a varsity letter, athletes must compete on the Varsity team and attend practices and compete for the entire season (those dismissed from the program for any reason will not receive a letter); additional lettering requirements are

- a. Place at County
- b. Qualify for State
- c. Notable improvement quantified by dropping time throughout the season
- d. Demonstrate excellent sportsmanship
- e. Be deemed earning a varsity letter by the coaching staff (including by not limited to coachability, serious participation in practice, investment, etc.)

#### 6. ATTENDANCE POLICIES

As a member of the Allatoona Swim and Dive Program, you are required to contribute your part. Rosters are based entirely upon practice performance and missing a significant number of practices will impact your ability to be selected to compete.

As a result, the following attendance rules are necessary and will be enforced:

- Athletes must be present at school for at least ½ of the school day in order to participate in practices or meets that day.
- Athletes must schedule appointments and work schedules around all swim and dive activities.
- Athletes must be present at all practices, meets, fundraisers, picture days, and any other activities designated by the coach.
- Excused absences include death in the family, signed doctor's excuse that indicates
  the time and date of the sickness or injury, school-related trips, and any other excused
  absences are at the discretion of the coach and will be addressed on an individual
  basis (these absences must be approved by the coach at least 24 hours prior to the
  missed activity).
- As a high school athlete, it is the responsibility of the athlete to communicate directly with the coach regarding any attendance issues.
- Frequent, unexcused absences could result in not competing at meets or dismissal from the program at the coach's discretion.

#### 7. FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

#### Swim and Dive dues - \$400

Every attempt will be made to cut down on the personal costs of the athlete. **Every athlete is required to participate in all fundraising activities. All fees are non-refundable.** If an athlete quits or is removed for any reason, a refund cannot be issued

# **AHS Swim and Dive Expectations**

The following items are a list of non-negotiable things that we value to make our program successful. It is with full expectation that athletes will follow these rules.

- 1. Be Passionate about your improvement in the sport. Always look to learn and perfect.
- 2. We expect our athletes to be engaged during meets. Celebrating achievement and encouraging teammates through cheering is wanted; however excessive or unsportsmanlike celebrations will not be tolerated.
- 3. Always be respectful to teammates, coaches, and officials.
- 4. Give 100% during all practices, meets, etc.
- 5. Communication is key. Athletes are of the age that if they have issues with event or relay entries or any other issues they need to discuss them with the coaching staff.
- 6. Practice starts at the given time. Athletes are expected to be ready to go at that time, this includes gear.
- 7. There are to be NO cellphones used at practice or meets while Allatoona is racing (unless filming for college recruitment). It is important to support our team while they're in the water! The only acceptable time is if there is an emergency or otherwise permission given by the coaching staff.
- 8. If you are to miss practice the following must occur or consequences will be faced.
  - a. At least 24 hours notice unless emergency
  - b. Written documentation for absence
- 9. Consequences of missing practice include:
  - a. 1 unexcused = 1 mile run
  - b. 2 unexcused = 1 mile run and sit out 1 practice
  - c. 3 unexcused = 1 mile run and sit out 1 meet
  - d. 4+ unexcused = chance of being dismissed from team
