

Currently, Coach Soley is teaching Health/BPE/Teaching Apprentice Program Classes and is also the Head Coach for the Women's Varsity Tennis Team.

About the Program

Entering their sixteenth season as a program, Allatoona's volleyball team is one of the most successful sports programs at the school. The year 2018, the team played in their 1st state championship match. In past seasons, the team have been State Runner-up, Sweet 16 four times and the Elite 8 four times.
